# Taiwan GHS

Hazard Chemicals

GHS in Taiwan is being implemented in four stages, with the Ministry of Labor (MoL) having published three lists of hazardous substances subject to GHS compliance. 01

Classification - Classification and Labelling of Chemicals – General Rules (CNS 15030); The CNS 15030 serial standards (CNS 15030-1 to 15030-27)

Regulations

Scope - Regulation of Labelling and Hazard

Communication of Hazardous Chemicals (Nov 9th, 2018)

Additional - Taiwan's Occupational Safety and Health Act

# **GHS 1+1**

#### SDS and Label

Manifestations of GHS Hazard Communication

#### Required

Taiwan's GHS is managed by two departments due to the different regulatory scope, the Ministry of Labour (MoL) and the Environmental Protection Administration.

However, all hazadrous chemical in the list should have GHS classification and label.

#### SDS/MSDS

#### Safety Data Sheets (SDS)

- SDS should be completed in accordance with the relevant document - Content and Template for Safety Data Sheet.doc
- The text for the SDS shall be primarily in Chinese characters, and if necessary, foreign languages can be the supplement for workers to understand

#### Label

- 1. Hazard pictograms must be included
- Contents: Name; hazardous ingredients; signal words; hazard statements; precautionary statements; name, address, and telephone number of manufacturer, importer or supplier



#### **GHS Exemptions Scope**

- 1. Industrial waste
- 2. Tobacco or tobacco products
- 3. Food, beverages, drugs, cosmetics
- 4. Manufactured articles
- 5. General domestic consumer products not for industrial uses
- 6. Fire extinguishers
- Intermediate products undergoing chemical reactions in reactors or processes
- 8. Others designated by the central competent authority

# **SDS Withholding**

Product Security and Confidentiality Measures

Taiwan allows manufacturers/importers to apply for a withholding disclosure of SDS if there are ingredients in the product that involve trade secrets or national security.

#### Informations can apply to withhold the disclosure

#### **Ingredient Name**

Official component name of the hazardous chemical which requiring confidentiality



#### **CAS Number**

CAS number of the ingredients requiring confidentiality

#### **Ingredient Concentration**

Concentrations of hazardous chemical ingredients in the product/mixture



# Manufacturer, Importer, or Supplier Name

Name of the company/responsible person who needs this application 01

#### Chemicals Affecting Worker Safety

Workplaces allowed to expose the chemical substaances listed in the standard. 02

# Substances Under the CNS15030 Classification

- Acute toxicity (category 1, 2, 3)
- · Skin corrosion or irritation (category 1)
- Serious eye damage/eye irritation (category 1)
- · Respiratory and skin sensitization
- · Germ cell mutagenicity
- Carcinogenicity
- · Reproductive toxicity
- ......

#### Specified Chemical Substances

Other hazardous chemical substances designated or announced by the local competent authority in Taiwan that are not applicable to the withholding disclosure application.

Hazardous chemical ingredients excluded from Taiwan protection provision

# **Chemical Registration**

Chemical Substance Control Law

Both existing and new chemical substances should be registered when entering Taiwan.

Substances not listed in the Existing Chemical Substance Inventory (Taiwan ECSI) are new chemical substances.


# **Main Regulations**

Taiwan Toxic and Chemical Substances of Concern Control Act (TCCSCA) - New and Existing Chemical Substances Management

Taiwan's Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) - New Chemical Substances Management



#### **Registration Body**

The Only representative (OR) rules is not adopted in Taiwan.

- 1. Taiwan local applicants can either register directly or appoint a Third-Party Representative (TPR)
- 2. Foreign applicants cannot submit the registration themselves or appoint OR
- 3. The (potential) local Taiwan importer must register the substance

#### **Exemptions Scope**


- 1. Substances which occur in nature
- 2. Chemical substances in machines for test run purposes
- Inseparable intermediates from chemical reactions in the reaction vessel or production process
- 4. Chemical substances for national security / defense
- 5. Chemical substances under customs supervision
- 6. Chemical wastes
- 7. By-products or impurities with no commercial use
- 8. Mixtures (but individual constituents of mixtures still need the registration)
- Polymers that the 2% Rule is Applicable and listed on the inventory of existing chemical substances


All existing chemical substances manufactured or imported at ≥ 100 KG per year

Phase 2 Registration

First batch of priority existing chemical (PEC) substances published (106 in 27000)

All PEC  $\geq 1$  ton per year should be registered
